

FRAMING & PACKAGING

All work must be framed in simple (Nielsen like) black metal or wood frames no more than ½" thick on the front edge. All prints should be framed with Plexiglas, white standard mats, and ready to hang with hanging wires or D-rings. Place your framed print into a clear plastic bag before boxing. Please DO NOT use peanuts for with your packing materials, they are too messy for the gallery.

In the interest of space & installation considerations submissions will be collected on a "first-come-first-serve" basis. Submissions will be checked periodically and an announcement that space is filled will be made if necessary.

NOTE: Cotuit Center for the Arts welcomes and encourages "creative, innovative prints" and will accommodate a number of larger, 3-dimensional, video, or multi-media works that may not require frames. To submit a work that requires special hanging or displaying needs, please contact Michelle Law, curator/visual specialist, michelle@cotuitcenterforthearts.org, 508-428-0669. Please submit these ideas as early as possible to receive permission from the gallery for special accommodations.

SHIPPING OF WORK:

All work will be shipped or hand delivered to the Cotuit Center for the Arts. Shipped work should be sent attention to Michelle Law, Cotuit Center for the Arts, 4404 Falmouth Rd., Cotuit MA 02635, to arrive between (July 17 - 28, 2017). Each artist will be responsible for insuring their own work while in transit. While at the Center, it will be insured by them. NO work will be sent directly to the Boston Printmakers address.

Each artist will provide a pre-paid, UPS return shipping label including insurance along with gallery loan forms. Please provide sturdy packaging that can be re-used for return of work. (Double-boxing is recommended for sending framed works.) Tape an envelope with your name on it to the outer clear plastic bag that contains the gallery loan form and return shipping label. Please be sure these items are in a visible place while packing. Gallery loan forms will be emailed in advance of shipping date.

HAND DELIVERY AND PICK UP OF WORK

Hand delivered works may be dropped off on <u>Monday, July 31st, between 10am – 4pm</u>. Artists who hand delivered their work should pick up their work on Monday, September 18th between the hours of 10am – 4pm. Returned work will be shipped 1-3 days after the closing of the exhibition.

INSURANCE: Artists are responsible for their own insurance during shipping, to and from the gallery. Once at the Gallery, all work is insured.

SALES: A price list will be available in the gallery and sales will be encouraged. A 40% commission will be charged on all sales. Artists must assume the expense and responsibility of supplying to purchasers any additional prints in the edition that may be sold. Commissions will be collected by the Cotuit Center for the Arts, who will handle all sales and payments to artists.

LIABILITY

Every precaution will be taken in handling the prints submitted to *Marking Time: Celebrating the 70th Anniversary of The Boston Printmakers*. Cotuit Center for the Arts will assume responsibility for works in the exhibition from the time they are delivered to the gallery until they are picked up by the artist or shipper. Artwork in the gallery will be insured for 40% less than the selling price. Artists must insure their work while in transit to and from the exhibition. The Boston Printmakers assumes no responsibility in case of loss or damage to submitted or accepted works.

AGREEMENT

Completing this submission constitutes an agreement on the part of the entrant to all conditions set forth in the prospectus, including permission to use images of the exhibited work in print or on-line media for promotional, educational, or archival purposes.
