# INFORMATION FOR A TRAVELING SHOW

## **CONNECT: Small Prints by Members of the Boston Printmakers**

This small print show was developed in partnership with the venerable Providence Art Club in Rhode Island to celebrate our upcoming 75th anniversary in 2023. Prompted by the theme of "communication," with a suggested image size of that of a cell phone, but no larger than 8"x10", members of the Boston Printmakers were asked to create prints about "messaging," "news," or content they wanted to "post."

Little did we know when we designed the exhibit a pandemic would force people around the world to rely on technology to communicate!

The show was first exhibited at the Providence Art Club during March and April 2021.

## **CONNECT** is available to travel through December 2023

The total exhibition contains 130 prints, all are matted or mounted as appropriate and professionally presented under Plexiglas measuring 8"x10". The exhibition is hung with lightweight brackets which we will provide, fits well into a space of 36 linear feet or larger, and can be arranged creatively. We will be happy to share the cost of shipping with the hosting venue. If interested, we will provide further specifications.

Photos of the show and how it was hung at the Providence Art Club are available. All prints in the exhibition are available for sale. The Boston Printmakers will provide a price list and sales instructions along with a spreadsheet of the works to assist with printing wall labels and recording the intake and return of prints.

#### Information about The Boston Printmakers:

The Boston Printmakers is a North American print alliance with a juried membership of over 300 accomplished and emerging artists. The Boston Printmakers was founded by students returning to Boston's prominent art schools after serving in WWII. After successfully exhibiting their prints in national shows, the group believed that Boston should be the home of a printmakers' organization and the venue for a national exhibition. As the newly formed organization flourished during the postwar period, membership soon included not only local artists but artists from across North America. Today, the North American Print Biennial is one of the longest-running and most influential printmaking exhibitions.

#### **Educational Gift**

One of the premier American printmaking collectives of the twentieth century, The Boston Printmakers' history has been documented in the book *Sixty Years of North American Prints*, written by David Acton. This publication contains a narrative history of the organization and of printmaking in North America.

Should you decide to host this exhibit your organization will receive a complimentary copy of this book to easily share the rich, evolving history of The Boston Printmakers with your audience.
